### **Bi-Metallic HSS Holesaw**



#### **USER INSTRUCTIONS**

- Wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E) when using holesaws.
- Ensure holesaw is correctly attached to the relevant adaptor for your machine.
- Use holesaw at the recommended speeds for the material being drilled as shown in the chart.
- Use as appropriate cutting lubricant when drilling in steel.
- After producing a hole, remove the "slug" of the material from the throat of the holesaw before commencing another hole.
- After pilot drill penetration be careful not to "bang" the holesaw onto the surface of the material to be drilled. This could damage or break the cutting teeth.
